Dear Parents/Carers

We are delighted to be able to offer our Reception & Nursery children a trip to Peak Wildlife Park on Thursday 4th June 2026. During the visit, we will be learning all about bears/mini beasts and farms that are linked in with our topics.

Children will need to be at Co-op Academy Hamilton at **8.40am** promptly. We anticipate that we will return back to the academy for the children's normal collection time of 3.00/3.10pm. The children will be dismissed from their normal collection point. All children are to wear full academy uniform and suitable footwear/weather appropriate clothing. Nursery children are requested to bring in a packed lunch (no glass bottles, fizzy drinks sweets or chocolate please) in a clearly labelled carrier bag, which can be thrown away after lunch. If your child currently receives free school meals, he/she will be provided with a packed lunch from school. Reception children will be provided with a packed lunch. No additional snacks will be necessary.

Parents/carers are requested to make a contribution of **£18.04**, consent to their child attending the trip, via Arbor, as well as providing any details re. travel sickness (via Class Dojo.) **Payment and consent/travel sickness information is required by all parents/carers no later than 14th May 2026** to allow time for the necessary paperwork to be completed. Please be advised that all monies paid are non-refundable. The contribution can also be made in three instalments of:

£6.00 by Thursday 12th March
£6.00 by Thursday 16th April
£6.04 by Thursday 14th May

We're sure that this will be a wonderful experience, however, we are only able to go **if all payments are received by 14th May 2026**. We will notify parents/carers if we do need to cancel the trip due to not receiving payments.
